Dear Madam:

Reference is made to your personal request of July 17, 1939, for the Revolutionary War record of Spencer Sharp, of Virginia, File No. R. 9427, also a tracing of his signature as shown in his claim for pension.

The record follows of the only Spencer Sharp found in the Revolutionary War pension records of this office. The data therein were obtained from pension claim, R. 9427, based upon his service in that war.

The date and place of birth of Spencer Sharp, his age, and the names of his parents were not given.

Spencer Sharp enlisted, place not stated, and served three months as private in Captain Robert Warren's company in the Virginia troops, his tour expiring in the spring of 1781, no further details of service given.

While a resident of Washington County, Ohio, Spencer Sharp applied December 27, 1849, for pension which might have been due on account of his Revolutionary War service. His claim for pension was not allowed as he did not render six months service as required by the pension law.

There are no family data in the claim of Spencer Sharp, nor is the date of his death shown.
